**PARENT/GUARDIAN WAIVER, RELEASE
AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT**

The Texas State Aquarium Association, Inc., a Texas non-profit corporation ("TSA"), conducts SeaCamp, which includes outdoor research projects, water safety instruction (including snorkeling), arts and crafts, collecting, animal care, aquarium care, and other activities for children. If you would like your minor child to participate in SeaCamp, please complete, sign the reverse side, and return this Waiver, Release, and Indemnification Agreement.

The undersigned parties ("the undersigned") hereby consent to participation by the child listed above to participate in SeaCamp and consent, acknowledge, agree, and represent to and with TSA, as follows:

1. The undersigned understand that certain SeaCamp activities may take place away from TSA's premises. The undersigned consent to the child's participation in such activities and any transportation to and from.
2. TSA's First Aid Certified personnel are authorized to give appropriate medical consents and authorizations on the undersigned's behalf with respect to any medical emergency or condition involving the child in connection with the child's participation in SeaCamp.
3. The undersigned individually and on behalf of the child hereby release TSA and its respective officers, employees, volunteers, and agents (collectively "the releasees") from any liability to the undersigned, the child, his/her personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin in respect of any and all damage, loss, or cost, and any and all claims or demands therefore, on account of injury, including death, to the child or otherwise, which results from accident or other occurrence in connection with the child's participation in SeaCamp, whether caused by the negligence, **except the sole or gross negligence**, of any one or more of the releasees or otherwise.
4. The undersigned shall indemnify and hold harmless each of the releasees from any loss, liability, or claim arising in connection with the child's participation in SeaCamp, including in connection with any injury or death of the child or other loss or cost arising in connection

with the child's participation in SeaCamp, whether caused by the negligence, **except the sole or gross negligence**, of any one or more of the indemnitees or otherwise.

5. The undersigned understand and accept the risks and responsibilities associated with the child's being a participant in SeaCamp and have been given the opportunity to request further information from TSA personnel regarding those risks and to explain such risks to the child.
6. The undersigned agree to accept full financial and legal responsibility for any acts of vandalism or destruction committed by the child.
7. The undersigned have read, understood, and voluntarily signed this waiver, release, and indemnity agreement.
8. The undersigned are, in fact, the sole parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of the child and are herein acting in such capacities. The undersigned agree to indemnify and hold each of the releasees harmless from and against any liability, loss, or claim whatsoever, arising by any reason of breach by the undersigned of the foregoing representations and warranties regarding their capacity.
9. I understand that due to the COVID-19 pandemic, all campers are required to wear face masks during Texas State Aquarium's SeaCamp event.
10. I acknowledge that the Texas State Aquarium will take reasonable precautions to ensure distancing and sanitation during the course of the event; however, I acknowledge that some COVID-19 risk factors may occur as a result of attending this program.
